Digital Safety

All of the schools within the David Ross Education Trust work closely with local Safeguarding boards to keep children safe. We have received advice on the use of tablets, Xboxes and other digital equipment.

Lots of children have had new devices and games for Christmas and seem to be enjoying playing the games available to them. However, the Safeguarding team have concerns about some games and activities.

Children have reported playing or watching adults play games that are inappropriate for their age such as Call of Duty or Grand Theft Auto which have excessive violence or sexual content. Children should only play on social media and games rated suitable for their age.

We need to advise you of the action we will take and why:

If your child is allowed access to games or content rated 18+ we are advised to contact the police and Children's Services as it is neglectful, leaves children vulnerable to acting out violent behaviours and can increase early sexualised behaviours.

We know that parents expect us to keep children safe so we will continue to work with you and your children to learn how to keep safe in a digital world. If you would like to talk to anyone about your child's digital safety, please contact myself or Mrs Glendinning. We would be happy to help.

Morning procedures

Please can parents allow children to come into school from the playground independently through the main doors. Please do not go around the back of the school. If you need to come into school in the morning please sign in at the office and collect a visitors badge.
